

What to do with your pup today:

- Put an [Adaptil collar](#) on your pup as soon as you can.
- Attach the [tagline](#) on your puppy's collar.
- Potty your puppy as soon as you get out of the car before going inside.
- Calmly introduce your family members to the pup.
- Give your pup a house tour on leash or tagline.
- Supervise your pup closely today to avoid accidents in the house.
- Give your pup some yummy treats from your hand.
- Train your puppy for 5-10 minutes.
 - Do [Step 1 of Teaching the Marker](#) or "Yes!" (2 minutes)
 - Do [Step 1 of Teaching Your Pup Its Name](#) (3 minutes)
 - Do [Lesson 1 of Crate Training](#) (4-8 minutes)

What NOT to do with your pup today:

- Have loud, exciting introductions to the family.
- Do not let children carry puppy around.
- This is not the day to show your puppy off to family/friends.
- Do not take the pup for a walk through the neighborhood.
- Do not introduce the puppy to any dogs except your own and [do those very carefully](#).
- Do not feed your pup [anywhere near other dogs](#).
- Do not give your pup fatty chew toys today to reduce the risk of diarrhea.
- Avoid dairy products today to reduce the risk of diarrhea.

What to expect from your pup today:

- Your pup will be somewhat stressed since it has left everything it has known up to this point.
- All of these puppy reactions are normal:
 - Some pups will be excited about the change.
 - Some pups will be overwhelmed.
 - A few pups will be afraid.
- Your puppy will have no idea about housetraining in your home.
- Your puppy may not eat well today. Warm its food before feeding to help.
- Your pup will likely be socially unsophisticated with people and dogs today.
- Your pup may get [diarrhea](#) from the stress of the move. [Be prepared!](#)
